***QUALIFICATIONS:***

The Case Manager, Community Reentry Services must have a four-year degree from an accredited university and one year of case management/direct service experience or an Associate's degree in social services, behavioral sciences, criminal justice, or a closely related field along with two years of applicable experience. Ability to demonstrate professional ethics, establishing firm and professional boundaries with both clients and agency personnel is a must. Ability to communicate effectively orally and in writing is required.

Must pass background check provided for the agency by the U.S. Department of Justice and the Family Care Safety Registry which includes the Missouri State Highway Patrol, Department of Social Services, Department of Mental Health and Department of Health and Senior Services. Must not be on any "do not hire" list with the Department of Mental Health or the Missouri Division of Family Services.

***ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:***

The Case Manager, Community Reentry Services must use sound judgment in managing corrections clients. Must have excellent communication skills and be able to work within a multi-disciplinary team environment. The ability to model appropriate behaviors and maintain professionalism is crucial in the delivery of services to this population. Maintain oversight and management of each resident making progress toward a successful re-entry back to the community is paramount. Reliable transportation and Class E driver's license are required. Regular and consistent attendance is an essential job function. This job classification is covered under the Agency's Exposure Control Plan. Employees in this job classification may reasonably anticipate being occupationally exposed to infectious materials. Current certification in CPR/First aid is required.

***SUPERVISION:***

This position is supervised and evaluated by the Director, Community Reentry Services or designee. This position has no supervisory requirements.
